The ProVation® Registry Reporter streamlines NCDR CathPCI Registry reporting by using procedure data generated from ProVation® MD software, as well as information gathered through interfaces to other IT systems.

Data required by the NCDR, including patient demographic and admission data, hemodynamic system data, and clinical documentation data, is highlighted and fed into the ProVation Registry Reporter for quarterly submission to the CathPCI Registry.

By making CathPCI Registry data requirements an integral part of the cardiologist's documentation workflow, the ProVation Registry Reporter boosts reporting efficiency and can increase data accuracy, allowing medical facilities to maximize ACC benchmarking and quality improvement data without sacrificing time, money or data integrity.

- Patient demographic and admission data

- Physician procedure documentation data including diagnostic and PCI information

Upon finalization of the procedure note in ProVation® MD software, this information is automatically sent to the ProVation Registry Reporter, which is then used to complete the data collection process and submit the data to the CathPCI Registry on a quarterly basis.

The end result is streamlined ACC benchmarking and reporting that saves time and improves accuracy.
