
With robust data-reporting capabilities, Provation software simplifies compliance reporting, streamlines workflow, and eliminates dictation, printing and chart storage costs.

The nurses appreciate that MultiCaregiver integrates seamlessly with key systems, such as scheduling and vitals monitoring, thereby eliminating duplicate data entry and speeding up pre- and post-operative processes, while anesthesiologists highlight the convenience of accessing the solution on their tablets.

"It gives us the freedom to move from pre-op into procedure and then to the post-op phase without having to log in and log back out in each location," said Dr. Ryan Green, M.D., Ph.D., site director, Walnut Creek Endoscopy. "We don't have to fight with clinical staff to access the stationary computers that are hardwired to the network. It has really allowed us to move seamlessly throughout the facility through all phases of patient care."

So, for example, the nurses do an intake history, which flows into the anesthesiologist's record and also to the GI doctors and into Provation MD," said Green. "We are all accessing it at the same time, so our time stamps are accurate, as well."

The time-stamp accuracy of Provation MD also benefits the center's compliance efforts.

Walnut Creek's staff is also looking to Provation solutions to facilitate the transition to ICD-10. That includes the ability to function in both ICD-9 and ICD-10 environments to accommodate differing conversion timelines.

"I know that with Provation, even with ASC-09 and ASC-10, whatever changes are made to CMS quality measures, we will be on the cutting edge," said Hunter-Nelson.


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Results: Improved Documentation, Streamlined Reporting and Billing
