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| Persistent Pathology Results Filters <ul style="list-style-type: none">Filters applied to the Pathology Results grid will now be retained when loading in new result sets. | Expanded text limit in Data Reports <ul style="list-style-type: none">The character limit for displaying results in Data Reports has been increased to 300 characters. | Interface Message History: Show full HL7 Messages <ul style="list-style-type: none">Full HL7 messages will be displayed when viewing previously sent messages. | Patient Merge <ul style="list-style-type: none">In the Manage Patients settings, users can now identify possible duplicates and merge patient records together. | Audit Log <ul style="list-style-type: none">A new report was added to the Provation CSV reports. The Audit Log report will allow users to track significant apex events over a specific period. |
| Amend any Procedure Note <ul style="list-style-type: none">Under the Exam Access tab, specific security groups can be permitted to put finalized notes into amendment mode 60 days after the original procedure date. | Delete Exams <ul style="list-style-type: none">Under the Exam Access tab, specific security groups can be granted the ability to Delete Exams, including patient information and documentation. | Rename Groups in Security Settings <ul style="list-style-type: none">Users with select access can click on the new pencil icon in the title bar and rename the existing security groups. | Image Capture Additional Security <ul style="list-style-type: none">A new security setting was added to allow select users access to Image Capture without giving them full access to the procedure note. | Date of Birth and Order Number added to Patient Profile Search <ul style="list-style-type: none">Apex has added the ability to search by patient Date of Birth or Order Number. |
