Higher Efficiency, Impressive Compliance

Further, the system proved valuable in monitoring adverse events, allowing the team to proactively identify trends and areas for improvement. This proactive approach ensures continuous improvement in patient care and contributes to the group's impressive 98% to 99% compliance rate on post-operative assessments.

"Provation iPro has really helped us increase our reliability and reputation with the hospital we contract with. The hospital's review committees couldn't read our charts and always asked for clarification on past procedures. There was no uniformity, but that went away completely overnight. They really love it because now they can actually read what happened." Dr. Chaudhry said, "Another problem was missing post-ops. We were only completing 30%-40% before. Now, we don't have that issue because the office can look and see which postop is missing, text that doctor to fill it out, and it's done right away on their tablet."

As a result, Provation iPro's accurate records of the Bergen Anesthesia Group's outstanding work has elevated their reputation, bolstered their negotiation negotiating power, and increased the sense of security with the hospital they serve. The hospital, in turn, benefits from enhanced reporting insights, a heightened reputation, and improved patient outcomes.

Boosting the Bottom Line

Users can wirelessly stream patient vitals from anesthesia monitor machines directly into Provation iPro. This, alongside a number of other intuitive features, including picture documentation, pre-filled procedure templates, and hard stops, allows providers to refocus their attention on the patient while simultaneously producing a more complete, compliant, and legible anesthesia record.

Plus, all of this data is available within Provation iPro's Analytics platform, which contains out-of-the-box reports for quality, administrative, billing, and clinical data.

"When we first began researching AIMS products, MACRA or the CMS quality measures were just starting to penalize, so we've been very happy to be able to collect data within Provation iPro and also to be able to analyze it too," said Dr. Chaudhry. "Some of my partners were skeptical about the cost of AIMS software at first, but that all changed the first time we got about \$30,000 or \$40,000 back from CMS and then on top of it we didn't get penalized."

The Bergen Anesthesia Group also leveraged Provation iPro greatly after the hospital's initial plan to introduce Pyxis machines was reconsidered due to concerns raised by the group.

So, instead, a solution was implemented using the Provation iPro, which allows detailed tracking of drugs administered to patients. This not only facilitated internal data tracking but also played a crucial role in external reporting, as the anesthesia group leveraged this data for reporting to NACOR.

"Before our billing was manual and we had to track people to submit vouchers. If that step was missed for 3-4 months, we couldn't collect," Dr. Chaudhry said. "Now, with Provation iPro, the minute you finalize the case, the voucher or all the billing information gets transmitted to our billing office automatically. Our billing office used to take those vouchers and manually enter them, which came with a fee, but now their workload has dropped significantly and has become more affordable for us."

In addition to streamlining billing management, Provation iPro offers real-time access to charge capture information. With these insights, anesthesia teams can optimize reimbursement, track and monitor the status of patient bills, and maintain a clear record of patient billing transactions.

"The other thing," Dr. Chaudhry said, "is that it was very easy to work with the support team. As anesthesiologists, our days are long, and we don't finish till six in the evening. Provation is the one company who will say, 'you know, you want to meet at 9:00 PM, we'll do it at 9:00 PM,' so we think it's an easy company to work with."
